### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- 1) Starting location- Wagon Train starts at Plumb Grove, North Martin Street, Clear Spring, Maryland. It is located at the intersection of North Martin Street and Broadfording Road in Clear Spring near the Clear Spring School complex. Friday, May 18,2018 night encampment. Please clean up after your animals. Manure spreader will be provided.
- 2) Food will be available for purchase Friday, May 18,2018 evening at Plumb Grove.
- 3) Breakfast sandwiches pickup 8 am on Saturday morning May 19,2018 FOR PRE-REGTRISTED PARTICIPANTS
- 4) Saturday, May 19 ,2018 night encampment will be east side of Funkstown Park. It will be NECESSARY to clean up after your animals. Bring the necessary tools. Manure spreader will be provided.
- 5) Bring a chair for Saturday, May 19,2018 night dinner. TWO MEAL TICKETS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR EACH WAGON AND/OR BUGGY. ALL OTHER WILL COST \$13 PER ADULT \$9 FOR CHILDREN 10 AND UNDER. RESERVATIONS WILL BE NECESSARY WITH REGISTRATION INFORMATION. No ticket no meal.
- 6) Sunday morning breakfast will be provided from the Williamsport Lions Club
- 7) REGISTRATION forms must be returned/postmarked by May 1. NO EXCEPTIONS..... any forms received after that date will be returned.
- 8) Buses will transport wagoner's: leave Funkstown Park at 8AM on Saturday May 19,2018 and 9AM on Sunday, May 20,2018 from Boonsboro's Shafer Park.

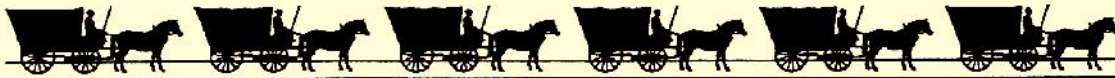

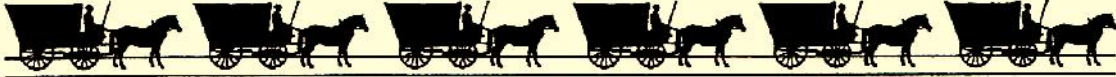

- **No ponying horses from another horse, they must have a bit of some sort, no rope halters, must wear helmet if under 18 years old, keep some space in between outriders (but not too much to allow traffic in between), Stay in line, no 2,3, or 4 wide (must be single file), may ride with a wagon if signed up with that wagon only!, must be accompanied by a legal adult if under the age of 18 years old!!**

## **2017 WAGON TRAIN TRAFFIC PATTERNS**

The wagon train will start from Clear Spring at Plumb Grove, at the intersection of Broadfording Road and North Martin Street, Clear Spring MD. Wagon train will depart **Saturday May 19th, 9 AM** traveling along Broadfording Road, in front of Clear Spring High School, a stop will be made to adjust harness if necessary before turning left onto Route 40, and we will travel east. After leaving Clear Spring, the wagon train will continue traveling on Route 40 towards Hagerstown and cross the following roads:

- ASHTON ROAD
- COHILL ROAD
- ELLIE WAY
- SHADY BOWER LANE
- GARRON DRIVE
- KNEPPER ROAD
- ST. PAUL ROAD (both left& right)
- SPARROW LANE
- CLEAR BROOK LANE
- SPICKLER ROAD

We will pull into Wilson Store Complex by turning right off Route 40 onto Rufus Wilson Road. When leaving the complex, we will turn right on Cedar Ridge Road, travel about thirty (30) yards. And turn right off Cedar Ridge Road back onto Route 40. Once again traveling Route 40 toward Hagerstown, we will cross the following Roads

We will leave Route 40 where it connects with Route 144 (Washington Street) and follow Washington Street into Hagerstown, crossing the following road intersections:

- RICHWOOD DRIVE
- DELWOOD AVENUE
- CEDAR CREST AVENUE
- INSURANE WAY
- HUMP ROAD
- PARK AVENUE
- WEST PLACE
- MONT VALLA AVENUE (north & south)
- EAST PLACE
- NOTTINGHAM ROAD
- DEVONSHIRE ROAD
- WAKEFIELD ROAD
- ROSS STREET
- AVALON AVENUE
- SUMMER STREET
- ELGIN BOULEVARD
- ALEXANDER STREET
- WINTER STREET

Continuing on West Washington Street we will cross the following street intersections:

- WHERE ROUTE 40, ANTIETAM STREET AND WASHINGTON STREET INTERSECT
- HIGH STREET
- BURHANS BOULEVARD
- WALNUT STREET
- PROSPECT STREET

**Sunday May 20<sup>th</sup>, 10AM**, Leaving Funkstown Park turning left onto Beaver Creek Road and left again onto Alt. Rt. 40 (Old National Pike) and cross the following intersections on our way to Boonsboro:

At this point we will enter Boonsboro and continue on Alt. Rt. 40 until we reach Park Drive, turning right into Shafer Memorial Park.

Wagon train will remain for approximately 1 hour (60) minutes before disassembling.
